The Hubert Reddick Endowed Scholarship was established in 2014 to support students majoring in Sociology and Social Work in the College of Social Sciences, Arts and Humanities at Florida A&M University. Two (2) scholarships of \$1,500 each, one for Social Work and one for Sociology, will be awarded for the ensuing academic year. Scholarship recipients must have and maintain a 2.8 cumulative grade point average and must demonstrate an unmet financial need. The scholarship award may be used for tuition, books, and fees and will be disbursed through the FAMU Office of Financial Aid, which will confirm financial need.

In addition to this typed application, please attach an unofficial transcript, one letter from a professional reference and a 500 word essay. The essay should describe 1) how you are working on achieving your career goals 2) service activities in which you are engaged that are consistent with your major, and 3) a unique characteristic that you possess which sets you apart from others.
